Georgia Mountain Soccer Spring 2010 General Information

Below is some general information for the upcoming season.

This fall we will offer soccer in the below age groups. Your child's age group is dependent upon their age **on August 1st, 2009**. The below chart will help in determining your Child's age group. ***In no event can a child under the age of 4, as of August 1st, 2009, participate in this year's soccer season.*** Play in the age groups above U-12 will be determined based on the number of registrations in those age groups. Game days listed are "normal days". Actual days may change due to number of teams and, for older age groups, GASA scheduling.

U-8	6 or 7	Tues., Thurs

U-14	12 or 13	Sat., Sun.

Practices: Practices are **normally** held two (2) days per week on Mondays, Tuesdays or Thursdays. Due to the number of teams and limited fields, team practice times will be established at the coaches meetings. Practice times will generally be 6:00 PM - 7:00 PM or 7:00 pm - 8:00 PM. Once games begin, many coaches will go to one scheduled practice per week.

Team Selection: Players returning from the Fall 2009 season have the option to remain on that team. Players that desire to change from the Fall 2009 team and players that did not play in the Fall season will be assigned to teams based on an open draft. After registrations are complete Coaches will have a Coaches meeting to select teams, one player at a time. Selection for practice time will be made at the same time. Parent preference for coaches, practice time etc., will be considered only so far as an open draft allows. Preference will be afforded to siblings in the same age group and players with unique travel requirements.

U-10 / U-12 Player Evaluation: U-10/U-12 player levels stress a higher level of competition than at the lower age groups. Because we use an open draft for team selections and not all players are known by the U-10 and U-12 Coaches we will be having an evaluation practice for these age groups. This is not a tryout. If they are registered they will be assigned to a team. It is simply a chance for the coaches to get to know players they may not be familiar with and to help ensure we have the most balanced teams in the fall. Your child is **not required to attend**. For those that are new to GMSA it would give them a great introduction.

Coaches: Currently all of our returning coaches are or will be Georgia State certified Coaches in their appropriate age groups. For new coaches this year we are offering a U-8 and below certification course. All of our Coaches and Assistant Coaches are required to undergo a state background investigation. **We are always looking for Coaching volunteers** - whether you have soccer experience or not we would be very grateful to have you as a coach or assistant coach.

Uniforms: Your registration fee includes the cost for your child's uniform. The uniform includes a jersey, shorts and pair of socks. At games your child must be in the appropriate uniform in order to play.

Required Equipment: GMSA will provide uniforms for your child as part of the registration fee. Parent's will need to make sure that each player has 1) Soccer shin guards, 2) socks to practice in that cover the shin guards, 3) Soccer cleats (not multi-purpose, football or baseball cleats - no center toe cleat allowed). We will try to help out with used equipment if it is available. Although, GMSA will provide balls for games and practice, it is recommended that your child have the appropriate size ball; U-6/U-8 size 3, U-10-U-12 size 4, U-14 and above size 5. Each child will also be expected to bring water/Gatorade etc to both practices and games.
